

Boston Marathon Waiver Recipient Selection Process

All Colonial Road Runners members are eligible to apply to the club for a Boston Marathon waiver. Even if you feel you don't qualify, we encourage everyone to apply.

We do not know the number of waivers we will receive until late fall. We also do not know the number of applications we will receive.

In the event that the number of applicants exceeds the number of available waivers, preference will be given to the members under the following criteria:

- * Are members of the club for at least two years at the time of marathon waiver application.
- * Members are restricted from receiving a waiver to once every three years (two years off between receiving marathon waivers).
- * Members must have run a full marathon within 2 years prior to November 30 in the year of waiver application.
- * Members will be given consideration based on the level of volunteerism in club activities for the present and the immediate past year. (Running in a road race is not considered volunteering.) Directing and organizing club activities will be given extra consideration.
- * If a Member returned a waiver from the previous year in time for an alternate to fill the waiver, the applicant will have a better priority of receiving a waiver.
- * If applying for a waiver, members will not be permitted to serve on the waiver selection committee.

Volunteering includes:

- Races that CRR directs or officially supports
- Timing approved timing events
- Serving on the Board of Directors
- Helping the Banquet Committee
- Serving on the Summer Picnic Committee
- Conducting Special Projects
- Helping with the newsletter
